Tier 3 Tier 2 **On-Site Monitoring Monitoring** Universal Tier 3: Intensive on-site collaborative monitoring by a team Risk comprised of ALL ESEA federal programs Assessment determined by the Tier 1 Universal Risk Assessment. **Monitoring**

Tier 2: Program specific supplemental technical assistance determined by Tier 1 outcomes, performance indicators and/or LEA request.

Tier 1: Program specific monitoring and support for all LEAs, which includes review of requested program deliverables.

Evaluation

- ESEA Section 4106(e)(1)(E) requires LEAs to include the program objectives and intended outcomes of activities within their application and how the LEA will periodically evaluate the effectiveness of the activities.
- Evaluation methodology should be included and discussed in the initial planning and development of programs and activities.
- An evaluation may not yield the expected results.

Evaluation: Implementation and Impact

ESEA Section 4106(e)(1)(E) requires LEAs to evaluate the effectiveness of the activities in the application which should include if the program objectives and intended outcomes of activities implemented under Sections 4107-4109 were met.

- 1. The LEA will submit documentation to show its plan to evaluate or the evaluation results of ONE activity for EACH Area of Focus (if applicable).
 - Well-Rounded Educational Opportunities
 - Safe & Healthy Students
 - Effective Use of Technology



March Uploads

Evaluation: Implementation and Impact

ESEA Section 4106(e)(1)(E) requires LEAs to evaluate the effectiveness of the activities in the application which should include if the program objectives and intended outcomes of activities implemented under Sections 4107-4109 were met.

Examples of documentation include, but are not limited to:

- Survey results
- Classroom measures such as pre and post tests or other assessments
- Software reports showing usage increase or user improvement
- Data comparisons
 - Example: behavioral or attendance comparison from previous school year
- Competition scores or ranking
